


Scoil Chorp Chriost



What was the idea

Scoil Chorp Chríost was built in 1966. It is a vibrant school community with students attending from Knockanure, Kilmorna, Bunneragh Listowel, Moyvane and the surrounding areas. In a school setting it is not all about the learning environment within the school walls, but also the learning and development of a child. The school planned to install an all-weather pitch which would increase available space and improve the levels of fitness for the school community along with the durability of a pitch that can be used all year-round.



Scoil Chorp Chríost had a small yard/playing area where outside space was limited with a field that was often too wet to play on. Upgrading to an all-weather pitch would double the size of the available playing area and the children could play without getting hurt, muddy or wet. The school consider participation in sporting activities to be very important. Pupils are encouraged to be active at all break times and a new Astro turf pitch would ensure that bad weather will not get in the way of having a safe available space for the children to play.

The school were successful in their application to the EirGrid Community Sponsorship Fund and plans are underway for a new all-weather pitch at Scoil Chorp Chríost.
