



# Murhur National School



## What was the idea

Murhur National School endeavours to enhance the self-esteem of everyone in the school community, to imbue in the pupil's respect for people and property and encourages in them the idea of being responsible. The principal and teachers aim at making the school a centre of excellence in which high professional standards are maintained and where pupils learn in a safe and happy environment. The school proposed to upgrade the school both internally and externally with replacement of old flooring and entrance areas, new doors and painting.



## Challenges

The school needed an overhaul, flooring had not been replaced in over 25 years. The overall benefits of this project would be phenomenal for the whole school community. An external upgrade of paint and replacing the front door would be a huge boost for the aesthetics of Moyvane, a village to which the school is central.



## How has this funding made a difference?

Replacement of the flooring means that staff, pupils and visitors are safe at all times while the new paint brightens up the school and makes for a more effective learning environment.
