

What was the idea

Moyvane Ladies Football Club are a juvenile Ladies Football Club consisting of players from the North Kerry/West Limerick region, mainly from Moyvane, Knockanure, Kilmorna and Tarbert. Participation in the club aims to improve girls footballing abilities but also their social, team participation and leadership skills through the playing of girl's football. The project to provide our members with their own jerseys for each age group and extra balls, will greatly add to training as the club were running low on gear.

Challenges

As club finances were very low, the group had lost their ability to fundraise from traditional sources. The club is a vital sporting outlet for young girls in the area and receiving funding from the EirGrid Community Sponsorship Fund was essential to having a well kitted out club and sufficient balls to help the team to develop their skills.
